Plate type	Plate description, including contribution requirements	
Share the Road	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made to the Share the Road Bicycle Support Fund.	\$89
Snowmobiler	Initial contribution of at least \$25 must be made in support of snowmobile safety education programs. No annual contribution is required.	\$89
Soil Conservation	Initial contribution of at least \$25 must be made in support of agricultural education programs. No annual contribution is required.	\$89
Special Interest	Vehicle must be 20 years old or older and must meet the requirements set forth in Utah Code Section 41-1a-102(57).	\$64
Utah Jazz	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made to the National Professional Men's Basketball Team support of women and children issues.	\$89
Utah Housing Opportunity (Realtor)	Annual contribution of at least \$30 must be made in support of affordable housing programs. Provide proof of membership in a trade organization for real estate licensees which has more than 15,000 Utah members.	\$94
Veterans	Initial contribution of at least \$25 must be made to the Utah Department of Veterans' and Military Affairs. An annual contribution of \$10 must be made thereafter. Applicant may select the Air Force, American Legion, Army, Coast Guard, Marines, or Navy plate.	\$89
Vintage	Vehicle must be at least 30 years old and not driven for general daily transportation.	\$64
Wildlife	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made in support of wildlife and wildlife habitat preservation. Applicant may select the Eagle, Elk, Trout, or Mule Deer plate.	\$89
Zion National Park	Annual contribution of at least \$25 must be made in support of Zion National Park preservation.	\$89

All plates, except for Amateur Radio, Search and Rescue Radio, and Purple Heart require payment of an additional fee of \$10 when renewing plates for the next registration year. Pursuant to R873-22M-35, any personalized plate that has not been renewed within 6 months of its original expiration date, will be forfeited.
